**CALL FOR POSTER ABSTRACTS
(Deadline: 15 May, 2017)**

The Organising Committee of the 13th APRSCP invites the submission of Poster abstracts for the 13th Asia Pacific Roundtable for Sustainable Consumption and Production (13th APRSCP) to be held in Kuala Lumpur in October 2017.

Asia and the Pacific is the fastest growing economic region in the world, and it accommodates the majority of the world population. In the pursuance for a sustainable world, the APRSCP believes that both consumption and production should be given equal importance. Sustainability continuously requires new, creative and innovative ways of thinking, new technologies, and new systems; and more importantly, strong partnerships among members in the region and beyond. The APRSCP was formed in 1997 to foster dialogue among industry, government, academia, and NGOs in the region to address pollution, development problems and solutions. The APRSCP has held 12 major roundtables in the region to date, with the strong network built in the entire Asia Pacific region.

The 13th APRSCP in Malaysia is a unique opportunity to enable regional and global researchers to present their project findings on key sustainability issues and innovative solutions to address such issues. This year's Roundtable will focus on showcasing those research project findings that may be of interest to the public and private sectors, with a view towards leading to commercialisation.

Roundtable sub-themes will cover:

1. Low Carbon Communities (e.g. sustainable lifestyles, tourism, buildings, transportation, cities, people, etc.),
2. Green Financing (e.g. financial economics, funding assistance, reducing financial risks through SCP, etc.),
3. Green Technologies (e-waste, energy, emerging technologies, renewables, water, etc.),
4. Innovations (food security and production, energy consumption, carbon footprint, SCP R & D, etc.)

Poster abstracts are hereby invited from interested researchers from consultancy, industry and business, government, academia, social entrepreneurs, and community organizations. The research findings should address issues relevant to the Asia Pacific region and particularly provide innovative solutions for Sustainable Consumption and Production in relation to the Roundtable sub-themes above.

Instructions for submission of Poster abstracts

Poster abstracts must not exceed 300 words and must be prepared in Word format, giving the title of the project, names of researchers, full contact details – including email address and a short biodata (50 words) of the lead researcher(s). The poster abstracts should describe the objectives, issues, project highlights and outcomes/findings as clearly as possible as decisions concerning their acceptance will be made entirely on the content of the poster abstract.

On acceptance, the Poster Presentation should be prepared as follows:

The Research/Project highlights should be described on a printed poster with text, photographs, graphics, leaflets and models. All posters must be in English. Printed posters should be no larger than 900mm wide and 1900mm high. If you are using photographs, graphics and pieces of text, these should also fit within the area of 900mm wide and 1900mm high.

Roundtable Fee

There is no funding available to sponsor the Poster Presenters. However the discounted Roundtable fee for the poster presenter is US\$200. The Roundtable fee covers the access to the 2-day Roundtable sessions and exhibition, Roundtable kit materials, two lunches, one reception cocktail, and coffee breaks. Poster Presenters need to arrange their own air and land travel, and hotel accommodation.
